

New Front Street Curbside Residential Waste Collection

STARTS Tuesday, October 13, 2015.

A few simple rules for placement and feeding of your roll out cart.

Placement of carts is important!

The automated pick-up arm on the truck can only operate if it has enough clearance to maneuver. We ask that you make reasonable effort to ensure that your cart is placed on non-obstructed level ground and that there is at minimum 1 metre (approx. 3 ft.) of clearance from any obstacle on all sides of the cart when you put it out for collection.

Cart Placement

For successful curbside collection, follow these easy steps:

- Have your cart out by 7 a.m. on your collection day.
- Place your cart on the street so that the wheels are toward the curb and the lid opens towards the street.
- Keep your cart one metre (approx. 3 ft) from any obstacle so the truck's robotic arm can grab it.
- Ensure that the lid is fully closed.
- **Overflowing carts will not be emptied.**
- Extra bags outside the cart or loose materials will not be picked up.
- If excess garbage is occasionally encountered you can take it to the nearest transfer station.
- Be a good neighbour.
Do not park in front of carts.

Using and taking care of your roll out cart:



Roll the cart out before 7:00 am on your collection day and bring your cart in after each collection. You do not need to set out your cart every week if it is not full.



Bag all garbage before placing it in the cart. Smaller bags help keep them from getting stuck in the cart. Rinse your cart occasionally.



Keep the lid closed. Do not let your cart overflow and do not place additional waste beside your cart.



Report any damaged or missing carts immediately to 403.845.4121. If possible store your cart away from direct sunlight in a secure location on your property.

If you move

Please DO NOT take your carts with you when you move. Carts are property of the municipality. If you need a cart at your new residence call the Rocky Mountain Regional Solid Waste Authority at 403.845.4121.

What can go into the cart

Your usual household waste, bagged and tied securely.

Keep these items out of your cart

- Any large items that interfere with lid closure.
- Hazardous and toxic waste such as chemicals, solvents, paint herbicides and pesticides.
- Medical waste or biological waste
- Construction and demolition waste such as bricks, lumber and concrete.
- Household appliances, electronics and furniture.
- Flammable substances and tires.
- Ashes or hot materials
- Liquids of any kind
- Fluorescent tubes
- Metal - these can be recycled at any of the Transfer stations
