

TOWN OF ROCKY MOUNTAIN HOUSE

BYLAW NO. 16/11 V

Being a Bylaw to amend the Water and Sewer Bylaw 01/09V of the Town of Rocky Mountain House.

WHEREAS it is deemed necessary and expedient to amend the Water and Sewer Bylaw 01/09V of the Town of Rocky Mountain House in the manner hereinafter appearing:

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Rocky Mountain House, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled and under the powers conferred upon it by the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M26.1 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1994, and amendments thereto, enacts as follows:

THAT Water and Sewer Bylaw 01/09V is hereby amended such that:

"INTERPRETATION AND APPLICATION

2. 20. "Temporary Kiosk" means any temporary or non-permanent structure used for retail, food and/or beverage sales and tourism related businesses that measures less than 107 square feet in total size and can be moved off of its location within a 24 hour period.
2. 26. "Mobile Commercial Sales" means the sale of items or provision of a service from a motor vehicle, or a trailer capable of being towed by a motor vehicle, or a cart or similar structure with attached wheels, or a portable marquee tent, any of which can be moved off a location in less than 4 hours.

NO OPTION FOR USE OF SERVICE

3. 4. No person shall have or operate an alternate source of water or sewer if the premise is adjacent to an existing mainline within the Town except:
 - (i) for any Temporary Kiosk or Mobile Commercial Sales that has received approval from the Public Health Inspector; or
 - (ii) where required within a provision of this Bylaw."
