

## Rocky Mountain House Council highlights from the Oct. 2, 2018 meeting

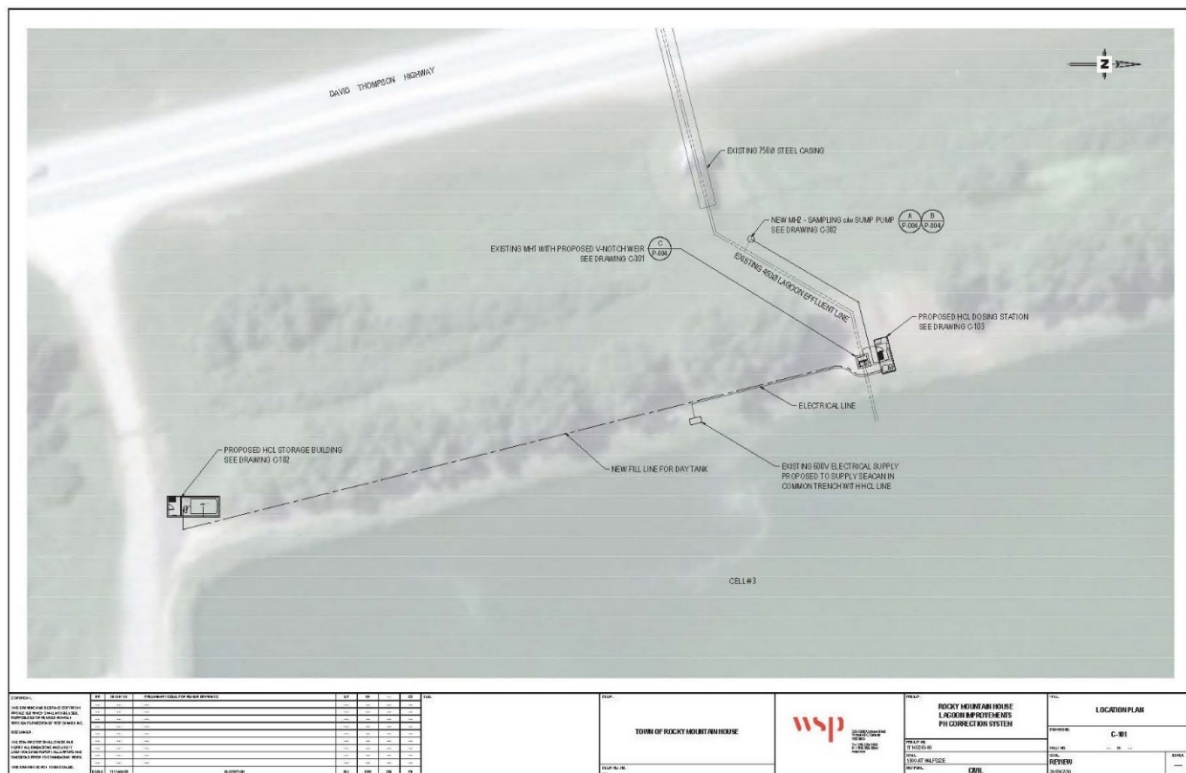
### Cannabis engagement results

Councillors reviewed [results of the Town's public engagement](#) survey regarding cannabis consumption and input from residents. Councillors debated the merits of implementing a bylaw based on the [provincial cannabis framework](#), and will get a first look at a draft bylaw at the Oct. 9 meeting.

### Wastewater Lagoon pH correction system

Alberta Environment and Parks has accepted the pH correction system project and issued the necessary approvals for the Town of Rocky Mountain House's wastewater lagoon. The Town has a tender closing date set for Oct. 18. If no acceptable bids are received, administration will conduct an invitational tender bid process, as approved by councillors on Oct. 2. Councillors have authorized up to \$461,065 for the project.

The construction of the [pH Correction system](#) will enable the Town's wastewater treatment effluent to meet the AEP Approval license and comply with Environment Canada receiving water body standards as it relates to lethality/toxicity levels.

### Subdivision and Development Appeal Board Bylaw

Councillors passed an updated Subdivision and Development Appeal Board bylaw 2018/27V, which authorized Council to appoint temporary members to the board.

## **Credit Union Co-op Aquatic Centre accessibility upgrades**

Accessibility improvements are coming to the Credit Union Co-op Aquatic Centre. Councillors approved the installation of a hydraulic lift and track in the family changeroom. The improvements were designed in consultation with the Spinal Cord Injury Association of Alberta to ensure our recreation facility can accommodate all patrons. The \$15,446 cost will be covered by the Credit Union Co-op sponsorship fund.
