

## **Rocky Mountain House Council highlights from the Nov. 13, 2018 regular meeting**

### **Rocky Mountain House National Historic Site**

Councillors welcomed four representatives from Parks Canada to discuss the Rocky Mountain House National Historic Site and introduce the site's Draft Management Plan currently under development. The site has seen a 30 per cent increase in visitation over the past five years, and managers expect that to grow as indigenous and community partnerships continue to flourish.
