



Water Conservation Incentive Rebate Program

Did you know...

Almost 30 per cent of all water consumed in your home is flushed down the toilet? Based on the CMHC Household Guide to Water Efficiency, an average family replacing an older toilet with a low-flow model can achieve water savings of more than 80,000 litres per year.

This can mean saving on your utility bill!

As a water conservation incentive, the Town of Rocky Mountain House offers its residents and commercial metered account holders a rebate for retrofitting old water-wasting toilets.

There is a **\$50 rebate** when a 13-litre or more toilet is replaced with a 6-litre toilet. There is a **\$100 rebate** when a 13-litre or more toilet is replaced with a dual-flush toilet.

To get either rebate, you will need to prove you have met all the requirements for the program.

Rebates will be issued as credits to the utility accounts. There is a maximum annual rebate total of \$200 per account.

Rebates will be allocated on a first-come first-serve basis only until current allocated funds are depleted.

How can I have the toilet installed?

A professional plumber may install your new toilet or you may install it yourself. Ensure that the toilet has been installed properly and according to the manufacturer's instructions.

Program eligibility

- *This offer applies to Rocky Mountain House residential and commercial metered account holders.*
- *Purchased toilets must be rated for 6 litres or less per flush.*
- *The toilet being replaced must be 13 litres or more flush volume.*
- *The applicant must provide photos of the old toilet prior to removal and new toilet after installation.*
- *The applicant must provide the original receipt from the purchase of the new eligible toilet.*
- *The applicant must complete the application form and declaration.*
- *Rebates will only be processed once all required documents are received.*
- *New homes, additions or basement developments **will not** be considered eligible for this program.*
