**Town of Rocky Mountain House request mediation for intermunicipal negotiations
in accordance with Stronger Together Agreement**

Rocky Mountain House, Alta. –

The Town of Rocky Mountain House has requested mediation with Clearwater County and the Village of Caroline to establish new agreements for regional fire rescue services, solid waste services and revenue sharing.

This request is in accordance with the problem-resolution guidelines in the [Stronger Together Agreement](#), which outlines that disagreements between municipalities shall be addressed:

- *At the earliest opportunity and at the point closest to where problems originate;*
- *In a swift, inexpensive and uncomplicated way;*
- *Using a clear procedural pathway to a solution; and*
- *To maintain a smooth working relationship even when disagreement survives.*

The Town of Rocky Mountain House is positive these issues will be resolved with the assistance of a mediator. The Town of Rocky Mountain House looks forward to working with our neighbouring municipalities for the betterment of the entire region.
