### Wastewater Lagoon aeration and desludging

Council approved a revised budget of \$2.1 million to undertake lagoon aeration and desludging upgrades. The bulk of the project will be funded through MSI, with \$247,115 coming from the Town's water/sewer restricted reserve and \$106,214 from Clearwater County.
