Clean Energy Improvement Program

Rocky Mountain House Town Council passed first reading of Clean Energy Improvement Tax Bylaw 2019/21V in accordance with [provincial legislation](#). Clean Energy Improvement Programs (CEIP) – also called PACE – are a voluntary way for property-owners to finance clean energy investments for their homes or businesses.

A public hearing has been set for Dec. 3, 2019 at 1 p.m. in Council Chambers.

Manufactured Homes Property Tax Transfer Bylaw 2019/20F

Rocky Mountain House Town Council passed first reading of Manufactured Homes Property Tax Transfer Bylaw 2019/20F. This bylaw will authorize owners of manufactured home communities to collect property taxes for the manufactured homes located on their properties, and remit those property taxes to the Town.

The bylaw will come into force after third reading, scheduled for Dec. 3, and take effect in the 2021 taxation year. There are five manufactured home communities affected by this bylaw. In accordance with the [Municipal Government Act](#), affected property owners will have a full year to adjust to the change.
