

# TOWN OF ROCKY MOUNTAIN HOUSE

## BYLAW NO. 09/06V

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BEING A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF ROCKY MOUNTAIN HOUSE TO GIVE EFFECT TO A PETITION OF ELECTORS REGARDING VIDEO LOTTERY TERMINALS

**WHEREAS** Section 232 of the Municipal Government Act provides that electors can petition Council to pass a bylaw on a subject within the jurisdiction of Council.

**AND WHEREAS** Council has received a petition requesting that Council pass a bylaw whereby Council recommends to the Provincial Government and the Alberta Gaming and Liquor Commission that video lottery terminals be allowed in the Town of Rocky Mountain House.

**AND WHEREAS** Council is obliged to pass such a bylaw according to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act.

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Council of the Town of Rocky Mountain House enacts as follows:

### Definitions

1. In this bylaw:

“Council” means the Municipal Council of the Town of Rocky Mountain House

“Municipal Government Act” means the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A 2000, c. M-26

### Recommendation

2. Council shall make a recommendation to the Alberta Solicitor General and Minister of Public Security and the Alberta Gaming and Liquor Commission that video lottery terminals be allowed in the Town of Rocky Mountain House.

3. The terms of the recommendation shall be as follows:

- (a) the recommendation shall be made in writing;
- (b) the wording of the recommendation shall be: “Town Council recommends that video lottery terminals be allowed in the Town of Rocky Mountain House”;
- (c) in addition to the wording of 3(b), Council may include in the recommendation such background information as considered necessary by Council;
- (d) any background information included by Council cannot contain statements that are contrary to the wording contained in 3(b);

- (e) if this bylaw is put to a vote of the electorate of Rocky Mountain House in accordance with the Municipal Government Act, the results of such a vote shall be included with the recommendation; and,
- (f) the recommendation shall be made within 30 days of the passage of this bylaw.
