2011 WATER CONSERVATION INCENTIVE REBATE PROGRAM

**** FOR 6 LITRE or DUAL FLUSH TOILETS****



Did you know...

Almost 30% of all water consumed in the home is flushed down the toilet?

Based on the "CMHC Household Guide to Water Efficiency", an average family replacing an older model toilet with a low flow model can achieve water savings of more than 80,000 liters per year. **This can mean saving on your bill!!!**

As a water conservation incentive the Town of Rocky Mountain House will offer its residents an incentive to retrofit old water wasting toilets.

This rebate program is also offering up to a **\$50** when a 13 litre or more toilet is retrofitted with a 6 litre toilet.

This rebate program is also offering up to a **\$100 rebate** when a 13 litre or more toilet is replaced with a dual-flush toilet.

REBATES WILL BE ALLOCATED ON A FIRST COME FIRST SERVE BASIS, AND ONLY UNTIL CURRENT ALLOCATED FUNDS LAST.

To get either rebate, you will need to prove you have met ALL the requirements for the program.

Once your application has been approved, your rebate will be issued as a credit to your water bill.

Program Eligibility

This offer applies to Rocky Mountain House residential and commercial metered customers.

- ❖ Purchased toilets must be rated for 6 litre or less per flush.
- ❖ The toilet being replaced must be 13 litre or more flush volume.
- ❖ Take a picture of the old toilet before removal.
- ❖ Take a picture of the new toilet after installation.
- ❖ Supply the original receipt of the purchase of the eligible toilet.
- ❖ Complete the rebate application form and declaration.

Rebates will be issued as credits to the utility bill. Since utility billing is issued on a bimonthly basis, it could take up to three months before you see the credit on your bill. There is a maximum rebate of \$200.00 in any year per account.

New homes, additions or basement developments will not be considered eligible for this program.
