### Centennial Campground

The Town of Rocky Mountain House hosted a four-day workshop in September 2019 for community residents to provide input into the future of Centennial Campground. Residents and Stakeholders developed two options: A redeveloped campground, or a residential/community development. Consultant V3 analyzed each of the options, including phased approaches, and will share the results at an open house on Thursday, Sept. 16 from 6 to 8 p.m. at the Lou Soppit Community Centre. *(Please note: COVID-19 protocols will be in effect).*
