



JULY 18 TORNADO

Our community recently experienced a tornado that resulted in extensive tree damage, safety hazards and road closures. The force of the storm was evident throughout affected areas, with numerous mature trees downed and others left in dangerous conditions.

The Town's emergency response began immediately following reports of damage. Emergency responders and Public Works crews were quickly dispatched to assess conditions, secure affected areas, clear priority routes and respond to resident concerns. Their swift action helped ensure access for emergency services and reduced immediate risks to public safety.

Following initial assessments, the Town mobilized contractors and additional resources to support recovery efforts. Cleanup operations focused on removing downed municipal trees, addressing hazardous standing trees, reopening roadways and restoring safe conditions for residents.

The scale of the damage serves as a reminder of the power of severe weather and the importance of community resilience. Recovery efforts have been organized with one primary goal: to make affected areas safe as quickly as possible while supporting residents through the cleanup process. Storm debris from municipal operations is being transported to the Giant Truck Wash snow dump site, where residents are also welcome to bring tree and wood debris resulting from the storm.

On behalf of Council and Administration, we extend our sincere thanks to our Public Works team, emergency responders, contractors, and residents who stepped up to assist neighbours and support one another in the days following the tornado. The resilience, compassion and community spirit demonstrated throughout this event have been truly inspiring.
