



CONSTRUCTION UPDATES

Each year, the Town of Rocky Mountain House Council approves capital and operational funds to keep our Town running smoothly. Here is an update on some of the more visible projects and maintenance work wrapping up this fall:

NEW ACTIVE DISTRICT OUTHOUSE

A new concrete vault outhouse is being installed adjacent to the multi-use trail and new bike park. This will enhance the Town's Active District, specifically the area of the recently installed bike park, disc golf course and dog park.

BIKE PARK PARKING LOT

The parking area next to the new bike park will serve the whole Active District. The site was cleared in 2025, and paving was completed in August.

WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT

This multi-year, \$30,000,000 project is nearly complete! The new plant is already treating your wastewater. Council will hold a ribbon-cutting with special guests on Sept. 17. Photos and details will appear in the October newsletter.

TRAIL AMENITIES

Additional trees and benches will be installed on the trail along Hwy. 11 east of 60 Street, and throughout Town.

PLAYGROUND UPGRADES

Riverview Park is getting a new playground. The park will be closed while the existing play structure is removed and new equipment is installed. For everyone's safety, please keep a safe distance from the work area and allow crews the space required to complete the project. Swainger Park will get a new slide, while Lichak Park will get a new climber. These are short projects that will be completed in less than a day. Watch for the temporary park closures posted locally.

CONCRETE AND PAVING REPAIR

This annual maintenance program includes the removal and replacement of damaged sidewalks, curb and gutter sections, pedestrian ramps and other concrete infrastructure, as well as patching and spot paving of surfaced roads, trails and outdoor courts. Residents can expect temporary traffic disruptions, sidewalk detours and short closures where necessary. This annual maintenance program helps improve the safety, accessibility, and longevity of our municipal infrastructure.
